- Annual Subscription Fee for one year (i.e. HK\$500.) should be paid if application is submitted in January to June, and for half a year (i.e. HK\$ 250.) if application is submitted in July to December. The annual subscription fee for the first year will be waived if the trainee fee HK\$500 has been fully paid for the current year.
- 2. The trainee fee HK\$500 will be waived if the Ordinary Membership Annual Subscription Fee is fully paid every year.
- 3. The annual subscription fee should be paid on or before 30th June for the each calendar year, i.e. 1st January to 31st December. If it is paid after 30th June, a late administrative surcharge of 5% will be levied AND your trainee status would be terminated as recommended by the Education Committee HKCEM.
- 4. The successful IEEM candidate must settle all the outstanding payments, including training subscription and course fees etc., with the College before they could be elected an Ordinary Member in the Council Meeting.

 College of Emergency Medicine, or a certified true copy of the certificate of an equivalent qualification to sit for Exit Examination
 for Emergency Medicine of the Hong Kong College of Emergency Medicine.
