

The 11th Call HKCEM RESEARCH GRANT

The HKCEM is pleased to announce that a grant of up to HK\$100,000 has been made available to support research in Emergency Medicine. All Fellows and Members of the HKCEM (who are in good standing with the HKCEM in the 12-month period prior to application) are eligible to apply.

Applications should be submitted to the Research Sub-Committee of the HKCEM by $\underline{\mathbf{16^{th}}}$ $\underline{\mathbf{September\ 2011}}$ with the intention of making the grant available three months later.

A standard research application form is available from the HKCEM. The application should outline the research proposal and how the applicants intend to use the grant money (there is no restriction on how this is used).

All applicants should include a one page CV from each investigator.

All projects should include a Fellow of the College who may either be the Principal Investigator of the project or a Supervisor. Applicants who are not Fellows of the College, should identify a Fellow of the College as their supervisor, should enclose their CV, and provide evidence of support for the proposal from the College Training Supervisor. Ideally projects should take no longer than 12 months to complete.

The grant holder should refer to the 'HKCEM Research Grant Guidelines' for further detailed information.

Any research supported by this grant should be independent of any commercial interests.
