- Elective trainees can apply for formal recognition of their EM training by the College for elective rotations in accredited training centres ≥ 3 months
- Application forms and other required documents can be downloaded from the HKCEM website
- Elective trainees have to fulfill the same training requirements as our College basic trainees for their Emergency Medicine experience (as basic training) to be recognized (Please refer to the file 'Summary of training assessment and half-yearly accreditation')
- Training experience should be accredited in the immediate next half-yearly training supervisor meeting
- An accreditation letter will be issued for successful applicant. The applicant has to keep this letter as record and proof of the accredited experience

Recognition of Emergency Medicine experience for Residents Without Parent College

- Residents without Parent College may apply for formal recognition of their EM training by the College for elective rotations in accredited training centres ≥ 3 months
- Concerned resident should check with the training supervisor that training post is available in the centre to accommodate him/her during the period in question
- A maximum of up to 6 months of Basic Training in Emergency Medicine can be recognized
- Application forms and other required documents can be downloaded from the HKCEM website
- Residents have to fulfill the same training requirements as our College basic trainees for their Emergency Medicine experience (as basic training) to be recognized (Please refer to the file 'Summary of training assessment and half-yearly accreditation')
